

event of illness before or during the trip. Trip cancellation/interruption and baggage insurance is available at a supplemental cost. Details and application will be sent to you upon receipt of your trip deposit.

Travel Insurance: Everyone who comes with us must have individual emergency evacuation insurance to cover emergencies, helicopter rescue costs, and incidental expenses such as extra travel (rejoining or repatriation) costs. The cost of this is included in the cost of the trip. You are strongly recommended to purchase additional insurance that provides cancellation and extra baggage fees.

FIRE reserves the right to cancel trips that are below trip minimum of 8 persons. All trip members will be notified a minimum of 30 days before the trip departs and will receive a full refund. If we cancel the trip in progress, you will receive a prorated refund based on the number of days not completed of the trip.

In the event of trip cancellation, FIRE is not responsible for additional expenses incurred by trip members (e.g. nonrefundable "advance purchase" air tickets, medical expenses, and passport and visa expenses). Any airline tickets issued are subject to the carrier's refund policy.

Responsibility: FIRE shall not be held liable for (a) any damage to, or loss of, property or injury to, or death of, persons occasioned directly or indirectly by an act of omission of any other provider, including but not limited to any defect in any aircraft, watercraft, or vehicle operated or provided by such other provider and (b) any loss or damage due to delay, cancellation, or disruption in any manner caused by the laws, regulations, acts or failures to act, demands, orders or interpositions of any government or any subdivision or agent thereof, or by acts of God, strikes, fire, flood, war, rebellion, terrorism, insurrection, sickness, quarantine, epidemics, theft, or any other causes beyond their control. The participant waives any claim against FIRE for any such loss, damage, injury, or death.

By registering for a FIRE trip, the participant certifies that he/she does not have any mental, physical, or other condition or disability that would create a hazard for him/herself or other participants.

FIRE reserves the right in their sole discretion to accept, decline to accept, or remove any participant on a Wild Earth Journey trip.

FIRE reserve the right, without penalty, to make changes in the published itinerary whenever, in their judgment, conditions warrant, or if they deem it necessary for the comfort, convenience, or safety of participants.

FIRE will not be liable for any air carrier's cancellation penalty incurred by the purchase of a nonrefundable ticket to or from the participant's departure city. Baggage and personal effects are at all times the sole responsibility of the participant. We will not be responsible for any refund for nonrefundable airline tickets or any airline tickets purchased by the passenger directly from an airline or travel agent.

Basis of Rates: All prices are based on two persons sharing a room or ger (yurt). All prices and fares are quoted in US dollars. The rates are based on current tariffs and are subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances. While we do everything to maintain the listed prices, if it is necessary to levy a surcharge, we reserve the right to do so, and notification will be given at the time of final invoicing.

Included in trip cost: Accommodation and meals (breakfast, lunch, dinner), all alcohol out side of Ulaanbaator, flights within Mongolia, pre-departure information, entrance fees, excursions, and sightseeing as noted and included in the itinerary, all gratuities except horsemen; ground transportation during the trip, transfers to and from group flights where applicable, services of FIRE and Wind Horse experts, guides, tour manager, and any other staff, taxes, port charges, baggage handling, service charges.

Not included: Air transportation to Mongolia and related fees, passport and visa expenses, baggage/accident/cancellation insurances, personal expenses, such as laundry, telephone calls, and alcoholic beverages in Ulaanbaator, and any other items not specifically noted.

Single/shared accommodation: A limited number of single rooms/ger is available at extra cost on a first-come, first-served basis. We will assist persons requesting a roommate. Participants will be notified if a suitable roommate is not available, in which case the single rate will be charged.

Itinerary charges: The itinerary is subject to modification and change by FIRE and Wind Horse. Every reasonable effort will be made to operate programs as planned, but alterations may occur after final itineraries are sent.

Health requirements: You must be in good physical and mental health. Any physical condition, diet, or treatment requiring special attention must be reported when reservations are made. You will be required to complete and send to us a Travel Profile Form giving your medical information, which will be treated in confidence.

Participant responsibility: Participants are responsible for being in sufficiently good health to undertake their trip and may be required to obtain a physician's release to participate in this trip. Members are also responsible for studying all pre-departure information; for bringing all detailed equipment and clothing; for conforming to standards of personal hygiene to minimize risk of traveler's disease; for acting in a manner considerate of fellow group members and the countries visited. Smoking is not permitted in busses, cars, tented camps and other designated nonsmoking areas.
